
Race and Ethnicity of Children and Teens with Coronavirus in Illinois Updated June 18, 2020

- As of June 18, 2020, there were 9,421 children and teens aged 0 to 19 years old who had tested positive for coronavirus in Illinois.
- Race and ethnicity data were missing for 26.4% of kids.
- ➤ Hispanics were 45.1% of all child cases, and 61.3% of cases for whom race and ethnicity was reported.
- ➤ Blacks were 12.3% of all child and teen cases.
- Whites comprised 9.9% of the child cases in Illinois.
